Year 3 will be visiting the **Rijksmuseum van Oudheden in Leiden**, on **Thursday 16th June 2011**. We will visit the Egyptology Department of the museum to support the children's learning in our new 'Ancient Egyptians' topic, which we will start after the half-term holiday. The museum has an excellent reputation for its Egyptology Department and the children will benefit from a guided tour of the antiquities.

Children should arrive in school as usual; the coach will leave at 9.00am and return to school by the end of the school day.

Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather and is wearing **school uniform**.

Children should bring a packed lunch and two drinks. They may also bring a snack to eat mid-morning. The bag you provide for your child must be small enough and light enough for them to carry as parking is not permitted in front of the museum and we will be walking a short distance through town from the coach park. Please **do not** include any glass bottles or jars or cans in your child's lunch-bag.
